ARTBOARDS & GUIDES

For today's activity, we are going to use and manipulate Artboards using the Artboard Tool (Shift + O).

EXERCISE 1

Make a new Artboard next to this one with the following settings:

- 1. Hit Plus Sign
- 2. Name the Artboard Exercise 1
- 3. Preset: iPhone 8/7/6
- 4. Go to Artboard Options
- 5. Portrait Mode
- 6. Show Crosshairs
- 7. Click OK
- 8. Move the new Artboard so it doesn't overlap one
- 9. In the Properties Panel > Rearrange All and set the artboards layout to Arrange by Column.

EXERCISE 2

Now let's add some Guides. On the Artboard you just made:

- 1. Go to View > Rulers > Show Rulers (Cmmd/Ctrl + R)
- 2. Right click on the Rulers and change to Inches
- 3. Draw a rectangle that is .5 inches from all the sides of the Artboard you created in Exercise 1
- 4. Select the rectangle
- 5. Go to View > Guides > Make Guides
- 6. Go to the Ruler and click and drag a guide from the top to the middle of the art board to create a vertical guide
- 7. Repeat step 6 but create a horizontal guide

EXERCISE 3

Make a new File and turn in along with this one

- 1. File > New
- 2. File Name: Last Name + First Name + Period + Exercise 3
- 3. Artboards: 9
- 4. Size: 300 pixels by 300 pixels
- 5. Go to More Settings
- 6. Columns: 3
- 7. Change Spacing to 0px
- 8. Next turn on the Grid m by going to View > Show Grid
- 9. Adjust the Grid size by going to Illustrator > Preferences > Guides & Grid and setting the Grid to 20 px and the color to Medium Blue.
