


3. DRAWING LINES

Start with the Line Segment Tool and draw a line, then using the Properties Panel, adjust the stroke. Then click on the word Stroke to access the Stroke panel to create dashed lines, arrow head lines, and profiled lines.

COMBINE:

Draw a line with Dashes, arrow head, with a 3 color gradient you have created.



WIDTH TOOL & STROKES:

Draw a curved line with the Pen Tool, set a 4 Pt stroke, then using the Width Tool (Shift + W), widen just one side of the line you drew.




4. EFFECTS AND BASIC SHAPES

SUNBURST:

1. Draw a circle .6 tall and wide (while holding down




2. Reverse the fill and the stroke, and turn the stroke up to 40 pt.



3. Then check Dashed Line and use these numbers:




FLOWER:

1. Draw a hexagon (while holding down the shift key)




2. Go to Effects > Distort & Transform > Pucker & Bloat. Set the Bloat to 75%.



3. Select the new flower and go to Object > Expand Appearance. Then add a circle to the center.


Hint: Reset your Stroke to no dashed line

COOKIE MONSTER:

1. Draw a circle. Go to Effects > Distort & Transform > Roughen and set the size to 1.5%, Detail to 90, & Smooth.




2. Then add a light gray circle with a black circle inside. Then select both & Right click > Transform > Rotate 284 and make a copy.



3. Then Right click > Transform > Reflect > Vertical. Place the 2 new eyes on your blue furry circle.



2. CHANGING BASIC SHAPES

TRIANGLE:


1. Draw a square *(while holding down the shift key)*




2. Select the square. Then use the Minus Anchor Point Tool remove a corner point.



3. Using the Selection tool, rotate the triangle.






STRAWBERRY:


1. Draw a circle *(while holding down the shift key)*



2. Select the circle. Then use the Direct Select Tool to pull down the bottom point.



3. Use the Direct Select Tool to flatten down the top point.
